Term 3 Curriculum

English - Exploring informative texts

In this unit, students read, view and listen to a range of texts to comprehend and compare the text structures and language features of imaginative and informative texts. Students create an informative text with a supporting image.

Maths

Number: Students will perform addition, subtraction, multiplication and division calculations using a range of efficient strategies.

Measurement: Students will measure, order and compare objects using length, area, capacity and mass.

Shape: Students will describe and represent two-dimensional shapes and three-dimensional objects. Year 3-6 students will measure, construct and solve problems using the properties of angles.

Science - Physical Sciences

Year 1-2: Students will explore how push or a pull affects how an object moves or changes shape.

Year 3-4: Students will investigate how forces can be exerted by one object on another through direct contact or from a distance.

Year 5: Students will investigate how electrical energy can be transferred and transformed in electrical circuits and can be generated from a range of sources.

Humanities and social sciences - Geography

Year 1-2: Students recognise that the world is divided into geographic divisions. Students describe how people in different places are connected to each other and identify influencing factors.

Year 3-4: Students recognise the importance of the environment. They describe and compare the diverse characteristics of different places at local to national scales. Students identify the interconnections between components of the environment and people.

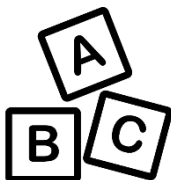
Year 5-6: Students describe, compare and explain how people, places, communities and environments are diverse and globally interconnected and identify the effects. Students recognise why choices about the allocation of resources involve trade-offs and explain the importance of information in consumer and financial decisions.

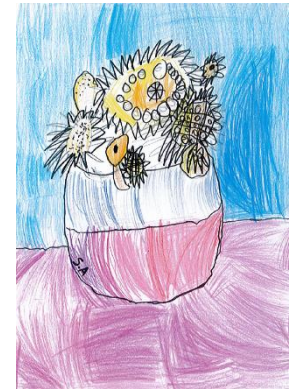
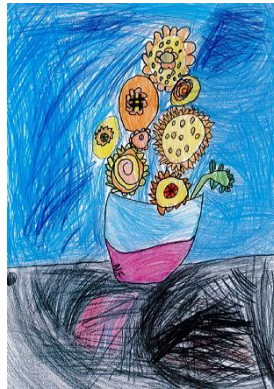

This is essential as it allows students to develop their language, literacy, creativity, social and emotional skills and create a positive attitude towards learning.

This term we will continue to concentrate on visual art as a way for the students to express themselves and further develop their creativity and artistic skills. At the end of last term the students explored different artists to understand how and why artworks are created and ways to use and apply visual conventions, such as line, shape, colour and texture. Inspired by our biology unit learning about living things and planting sunflower seeds in the school grounds, the students created their own versions of Vincent Van Gogh sunflowers.
