Term 4 Curriculum

English - Reading, writing and performing poetry

In English this term our focus will be around writing, comprehending and presenting poetry. We will be looking at rhyme, rhythm and poetic devices used to entertain an audience. You may hear some verses presented for homework throughout the term.

Maths

In Maths this term our focus will be around manipulating numbers to 100, fractions, skip counting, division and money. All students made wonderful improvement in their number fact recall last term and this will continue to be a focus in term 4.

Science - Chemical Sciences

Year 1-2: Students will investigate combinations of different materials and give reasons for the selection of particular materials according to their properties and purpose.

Year 3-4: Students investigate physical properties of materials and consider how these properties influence the selection of materials for particular purposes.

Year 5: Students will investigate changes that can be made to materials and how these changes are classified as reversible or irreversible.

To enhance the students' learning about money and financial maths we encourage them to practice in real life situations. If you're heading to the store or have coins and notes at home, provide them hands on opportunities to experience using money.
